Only horses that have successfully completed the Lusitano studbook process, ID included, will be allowed to participate. Each candidate will also represent his country.

For the contest 'Model and movements', the nationality of the owner of the participating horse is taken into account.

For the dressage and working equitation competition, the nationality of the rider is taken into account.

ARTICLE 1

ENTRIES AND PARTICIPATION RULES

The national Lusitano recognized associations of each participating country is responsible for the selection and inscription of all their participants in the championship. Participants must apply to the general rules and the rules of each discipline.

Entries must be submitted to the national Lusitano recognized association by the entity in whose name the horse is registered in the stud book.

- Models and Gaits: must refer to the "2024 European Championship Models and Gaits regulations" below.
- Dressage competition: must refer to the "2024 European Lusitano Dressage Championships regulations" below.
- Working equitation: must refer to the WAWE regulations.

All entry costs, that include stables reservations, must be paid at moment of inscription. No entry will be considered without the payment receipt.

No refund will be held after the invoice for subscription and reservation of stables.

All horses will be judged in a specified ring according to the program.

ARTICLE 2

ADMISSION

- 1. For all disciplines, once the horses have completed the registration process, there will be an administrative admission by the APSL where they will be checked.
- 2. The registered horses must be presented to the Admissions Jury, (Veterinary Inspection for Dressage) at the appropriate location in the enclosure being inspected on the 2nd and 3rd October according with the schedule.

Any horses not inspected by the Admissions Jury shall not be eligible to compete as this is the time when they are issued with competition number.

ARTICLE 3

HEALTH REGULATIONS

All horses registered for the Competition must meet the following health standards:

a) Be accompanied by their respective Passport – Equine Identity Document (Blue Book) or equivalent (EU recognized).

- b) Must have an "influenza" vaccination certificate (30 days in advance), as follows:
 - Primary vaccination two doses applied within a minimum interval of 21 and maximum of 92 days.
 - Revaccinations one dose, to be given within 12 months of the 2nd dose referred to in 1, with subsequent revaccinations being given strictly within a period of 12 months from the previous vaccination.
- c) The instructions and advice of the veterinary surgeon in attendance must always be complied with. This will take into consideration the instructions and advice of production laboratories, in addition to the sanitary conditions of the region of the accommodation and the current or future international contacts regarding more frequent revaccinations.

No equine shall be allowed to compete within a post vaccination period of 7 days.

Vaccinations must be registered on a special page in passports.

There must be no signs of any diseases, particularly of an infect-contagious type.

The President of the jury of each discipline reserves the right to immediately exclude a horse that shows signs of illness confirmed by the veterinarian present on site. The horse must leave the competition site immediately.

LUSITANO MODEL AND MOVEMENTS EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP 2024

ARTICLE 1

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

All horses should present:

- a) Proof of registration in the Birth Ledger of the Lusitano studbook and ID.
- b) The capacity to be led in-hand, in station, and performing the three paces. For some categories, the horse must be ridden (also to be presented in walk, trot and canter).
- c) Properly attired presenters and horses harnessed in accordance with the rider's outfit. Horses must be properly groomed.
- d) Prohibition of use of an assistant with a whip or switch, in order to assess the horse's willingness to move forward and its natural energy.







ARTICLE 2

CLASSIFICATION

- 1 Classification of each class will be the responsibility of a single official Breed judge from the commission of International Lusitano Breed Judges.
- 2 In classes in which horses from the Stud Farms of one (or several) of the members of the jury are competing, the said member (or members) shall be replaced by another (other) judge(s).
- 3 Each presenter will have a time limit of 2m30 (in the "in-hand" classes) and 3m00 (in the ridden classes) to present their horses (in the 40 x 20 m rectangle), and it is their responsibility to show the requested gaits in the allowed time, for both hands.
- 4 The classification of classes may be commented on by the judge in charge of each class.
- 5 Classes will be classified up to the fourth position or one quarter of the number of horses present at the initial classification, when numbering more than sixteen,
- 6 Prizes shall be awarded to the owners of classified horses, with a certificate to be presented to breeders.
- 7 Judges' decisions are not subject to appeal unless they are in breach of any conditions expressly set out in this Regulation.
- 8 In the event of an appeal, the appellant must indicate the regulatory disposition breached in addition to the time of its occurrence.
- 9 Appeals shall be submitted in writing to the President of the Jury, no later than one hour from the public announcement of the results of the classification together with a deposit of €100, which shall be returned if a breach has been committed.
- 10 Riders and presenters who, during the presentation or prize distribution, do not comply with the instructions of the judge/steward will be disqualified.

ARTICLE 3

PRIZES

1 Trophies shall be awarded to the winners of all classes and gold and silver medals awarded to

horses achieving classifications of "Excellent" or "Very Good", respectively.



- 2 Title of "Lusitano Male European Champion in hand", "Lusitano Male European Champion ridden", "Lusitano Female European Champion In hand", "Lusitano Female European Champion ridden" to the best horse of each sex according to whether they are ridden or presented in hand, from among the first places in the classes that have obtained a gold medal.
- 3 The title of "Lusitano European Male Champion" and "Lusitano European Female Champion" will be awarded to the best horse of each sex, among the once that obtained the title of champion referred in 2nd point of this article.
- 4 The "Lusitano European Champion of Champions" will be awarded among the champions referred in 3rd point of this article.
- 5 The title of "Lusitano European Champion Cup" shall be awarded to the nation achieving the highest points total, adding together the classifications of the two best horses in each individual class, in compliance with the following points scheme:
 - a) Points shall be awarded as follows:

1st place – 6 points

2nd place – 4 points

3rd place - 3 points

4th place – 2 points

5th place and the rest – 1 point

Plus a bonus of 5 points for each gold and 3 points for each silver medal.

The following points shall be awarded:

5 points to the breeder of the Female Champion

5 points to the breeder of the Male Champion

5 points to the breeder of the Champion of Champions

Points will be award to nation of the owner of the horse.

ARTICLE 4

COMPETITION CLASSES

The organizing committee reserves the right not to open classes with less than 3 participants.

Class VII – 5 Years Old and older	

Horses in the three-year-old classes and older age classes (Males and Females) will be presented in all three gaits (canter included) excluding Class IV – mares with foals.

In the ridden male horse classes (IV and V), the complete morphological development of the genital organs must be controlled by the Admissions Jury.

In the ridden and three-year-old classes (Males and Females) the horses will be presented in a 40*20 rectangle. The presenters/riders have a 3 minutes time to present their horses, where they will have to show them in the three movements, for both hands. At the end of the allowed time, the judges will finish judging the horses.

The one- and two-year-old classes (Males and Females) will also be presented in a rectangle at walk and trot.

The horses will only be presented in hand or mounted, no presentation in freedom is allowed.

LUSITANO WORKING EQUITATION EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP 2024

The Lusitano European working equitation championship will only take place if there are a minimum of 15 couples. Each country can submit up-to 4 couples.

The championship will consist in three tests (dressage, maneability and speed). The rules of each teste may apply to the WAWE regulation.


There will be individual and team championships. The points award for each championship apply to the WAWE rules page 48.

For the team championship the result of each country will be achieved by summing up the points of the three best couples in each test.

LUSITANO DRESSAGE EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP 2024

ARTICLE 1

COMPETITION

FEI International Dressage Rules for 2024 will apply.

The competition is "OPEN": it is not essential to have previously won other competitions or a medal to participate.

Competition and training rings will be a 20m x 60m sand arenas

Horse - Rider combinations can only participate in one test per day. Riders may present several horses in different levels.

ARTICLE 2

Each Level consists of two Tests, held in two different days. As follows:

4 YEAR OLD HORSES

- 1st Day: 4 Year Old horses Preliminary Test (Royal Spanish Federation Rules)
- 2nd Day: 4 Year Old horses Final Test (Royal Spanish Federation Rules)

5 YEAR OLD HORSES

- 1st Day: Preliminary Test 5 Year Old horses (FEI Test)
- 2nd Day: Final Test 4 Year Old horses (FEI Test)

6 YEAR OLD HORSES

- 1st Day: Preliminary Test 6 Year Old horses (FEI Test)
- 2nd Day: Final Test 6 Year Old horses (FEI Test)

7 YEAR OLD HORSES

- 1st Day: Preliminary Test 7 Year Old horses (FEI Test)
- 2nd Day: Final Test 7 Year Old horses (FEI Test)

SMALL TOUR

- Saint Georges Test (FEI)
- Intermediate I (FEI)

BIG TOUR

- Grand Prix (FEI)
- Grand Prix Special (FEI)

To qualify for the European Championship, Horse-Rider combination must take part in both days.

Final Individual Classification for the European Championship 2024 will be taking by adding the percentage of both days and dividing by 2.
